

MODEL PEMAHAMAN PERAWAT & BIDAN UPAYA *COMPLIANCE* PROSEDUR TRANSFUSI DARAH GUNA KESELAMATAN PASIEN

<p>Article History: Received 05/03/2025 Revised - Accepted 18/03/2025</p>	<p>Karakteristik personal, pemahaman, ingatan, kepuasan kerja serta komitmen organisasional berpengaruh terhadap <i>compliance</i> perawat & bidan pada prosedur transfusi darah; namun demikian karakteristik personal berpengaruh negatif signifikan terhadap pemahaman. <i>Compliance</i> pada prosedur transfusi darah berdampak pada keselamatan pasien. Tujuan penelitian ini menemukan model pemahaman perawat & bidan sebagai upaya peningkatan <i>compliance</i> mereka pada prosedur transfusi darah. Disain yang digunakan adalah observasional analitik <i>cross-sectional</i> yang didukung 156 orang responden dan 46 orang observer. Data dianalisis secara <i>diskriptif</i>, <i>korelasional</i> serta <i>structural equation modelling</i>. Berdasarkan hasil temuan model, pemahaman perawat & bidan bisa ditingkatkan melalui saran kepada pimpinan institusi: (a) peningkatan pendidikan perawat & bidan; (b) penyelenggaraan seminar dan workshop transfusi darah secara rutin setiap 6 bulan sekali.</p>
<p>Keywords: <i>Comprehension model</i> <i>Blood Transfusion Procedure</i> <i>Nurse & Midwife Compliance</i> <i>Patient Safety</i></p>	<p>ABSTRACT <i>Personal characteristics, understanding, memory, job satisfaction and organizational commitment influence the compliance of nurses & midwives in blood transfusion procedures; however, personal characteristics have a significant negative effect on understanding. Compliance with blood transfusion procedures has an impact on patient safety. The aim of this research is to find a model for understanding nurses & midwives as an effort to increase their compliance with blood transfusion procedures. The design used was cross-sectional analytical observational supported by 156 respondents and 46 observers. Data were analyzed descriptively, correlationally and structural equation modeling. Based on the model findings, the understanding of nurses & midwives can be improved through suggestions to institutional leaders: (a) improving the education of nurses & midwives; (b) holding regular blood transfusion seminars and workshops every 6 months.</i></p>
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
